English

Maths

Counting will be a big part of our maths lessons to ensure children have a good understanding of numbers up to 100. We will then look at place value moving onto the hundreds. Addition and subtraction will be next, where we will begin to use more formal methods. Don't worry we will still be using lots of resources!

R.E.

Our topic is called 'people of God.' We will find out about the story of Noah and how his covenant with God is important for Christians.

French

Bonjour ca va? Our topic is all about 'getting to know you'. Children will learn some basic conversation, such as 'how are you?', 'I am ... years old'.

Children will be focusing on their balancing and footwork skills. They will also learn about challenging themselves and how to persevere.

Computing

In computing, the children will be looking at how computers are connected. Children will learn about the different parts of digital devices, and how these help us.
