At Triangle, we have a number of pupils who utilise sensory resources during the school day. These may form a key aspect of their targeted provision and have been recommended by health and / or educational professionals. It is however becoming increasingly apparent that a number of pupils are bringing in chews and toys from home that do not adhere to key health and safety measures, with some proving to be an actual choking hazard. We are therefore kindly requesting that you refrain from allowing your child to bring in any such items. As a school we have a wide range of resources on site that we distribute to pupils when recommendations suggest these will have a positive impact on their engagement and access to education. These are specifically designed for this purpose as well as being safe, easy to clean and minimise disruption within the classroom environment.
