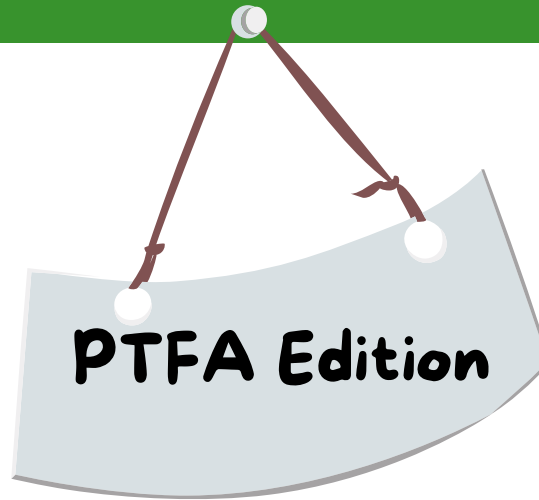

Secretary - Will Hodgson (Parent of Hector and Beatrice in Y6)

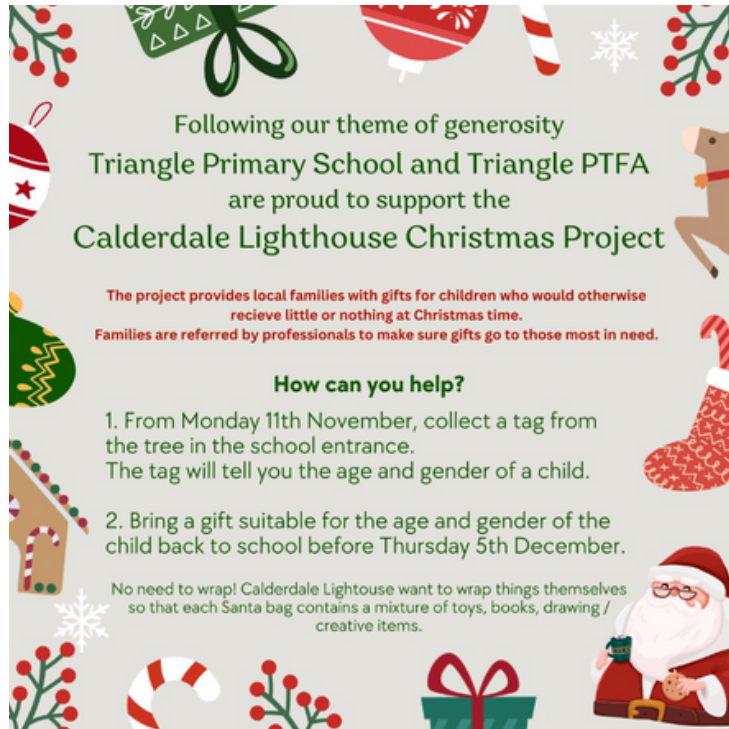
Treasurer - Asma Haslam (Parent of Rohan in Y3 and Ethan in Y5)
