The Triangle Way - What does it mean?

This week marks the launch of "The Triangle Way," a streamlined and refreshed set of school rules and routines. As noted in the newsletter prior to Christmas, we will support the children in learning these new guidelines throughout this half-term.

We are implementing this initiative in two primary ways: first, by eliminating all individual class rules in favour of a concise set of school-wide rules that we expect all students to adhere to, regardless of their location within the school. Second, we are concentrating on a limited number of rules and routines each week to prevent overwhelming the children.

This week, our focus has been on the concept of being "Ready to Learn," which aligns with our "Gold" Standard. I will include our behaviour curriculum in an upcoming newsletter for your review.
